1. As of 13 October 2009, there are 258 projects in the IAI Work Plan I, at various stages of implementation. Funding has been secured for 217 projects (84%), of which 186 projects have been completed, 26 projects are under implementation and 4 projects are being planned for implementation. 5 Projects have secured partial funding, 14 projects are in matching process and 22 projects have yet to be funded.

Contribution by Dialogue Partners and Development Agencies

3. In addition to the ASEAN-6 contribution to the IAI Work Plan, 17 dialogue partners and development agencies are providing funding assistance to 84 projects totalling US\$ 21.92 million. The top five donors are Japan, the Republic of Korea, India, Norway, and European Union, contributing about US\$ 18.4 million (or 87% of the total funding by donors). Table 5 shows the amount of funding secured for the IAI projects from ASEAN's dialogue partners and development agencies.
