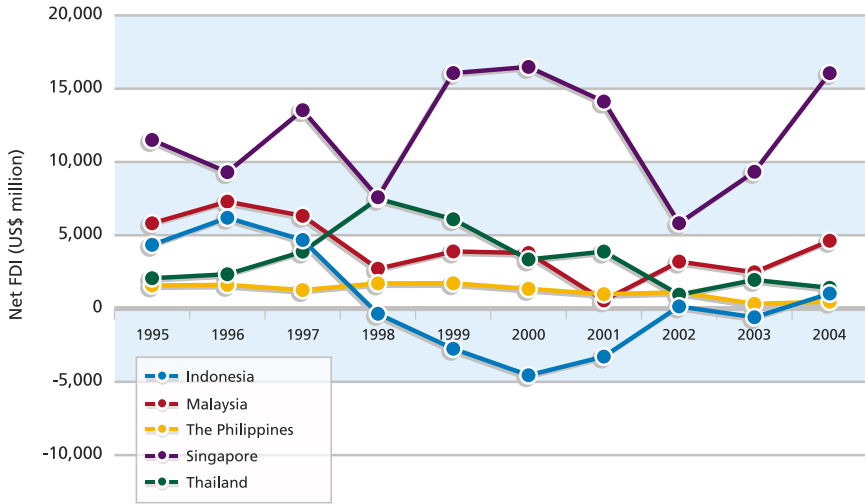

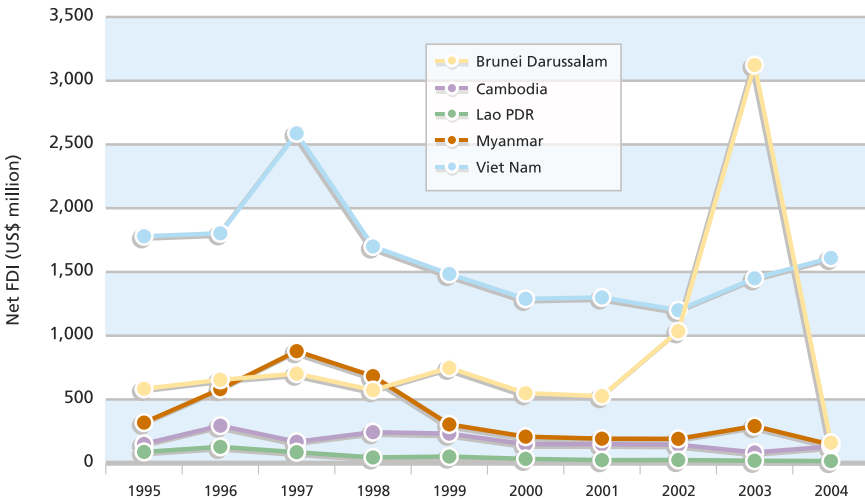

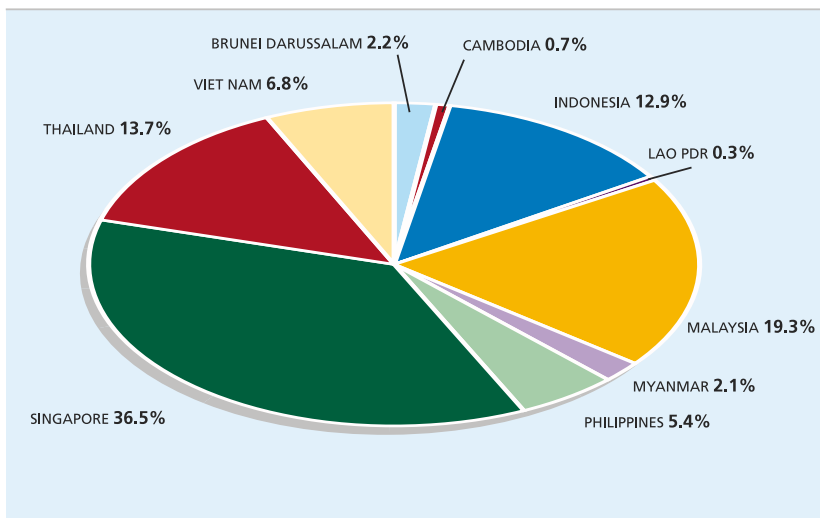

Foreign Direct Investments in ASEAN by Host Country, 1995-2004

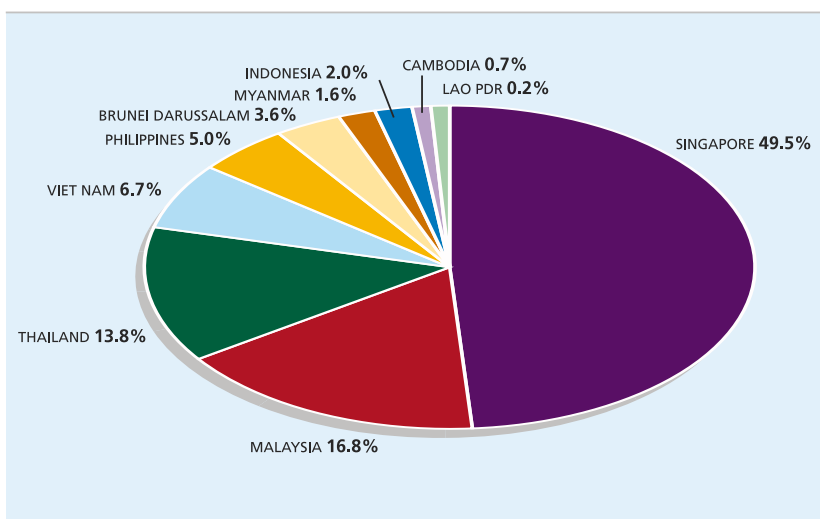

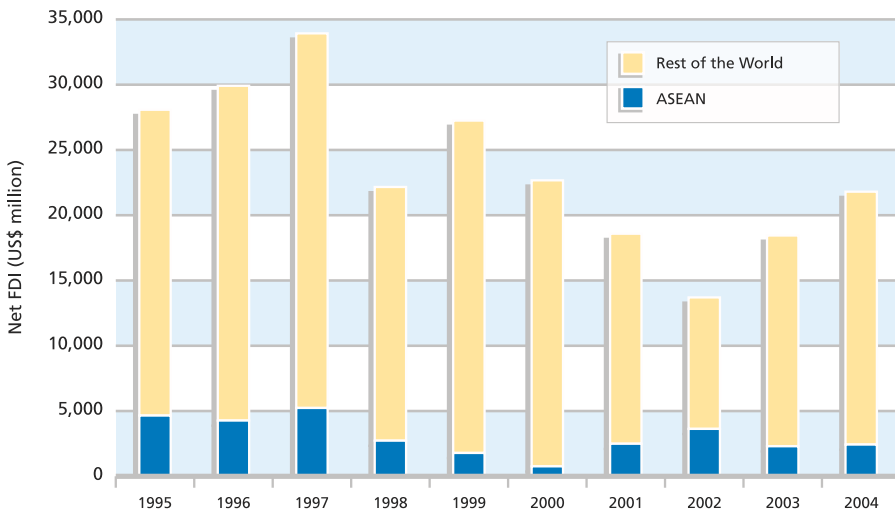

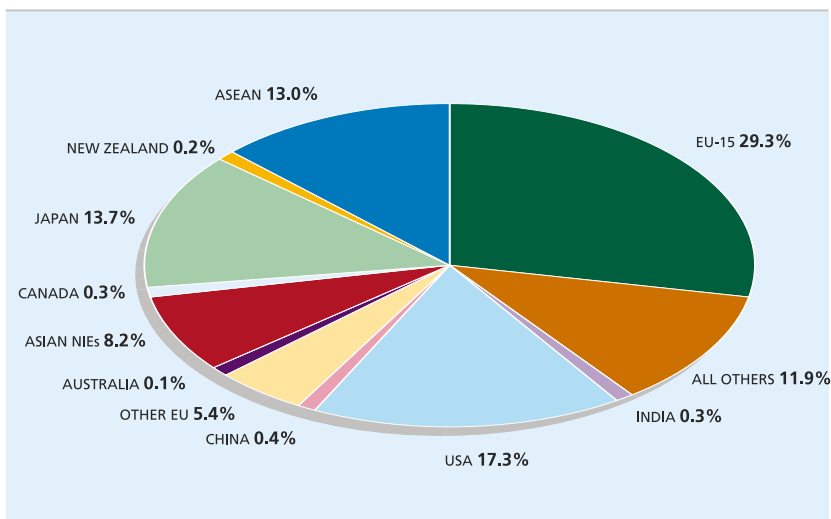

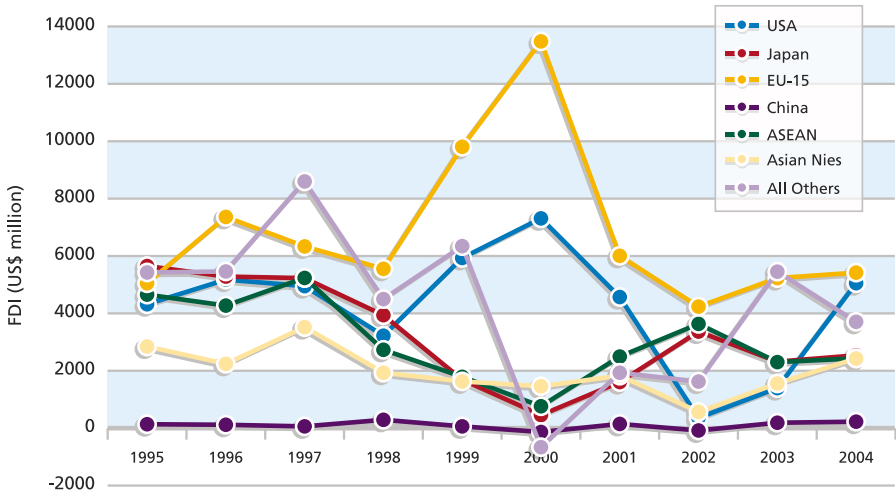

Composition of Foreign Direct Investments in ASEAN by Source Country, 1995-2004

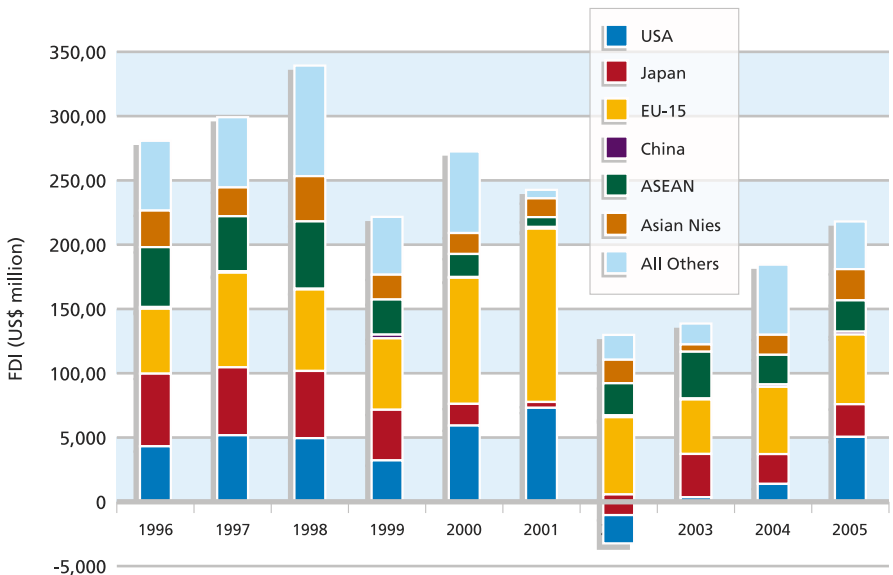

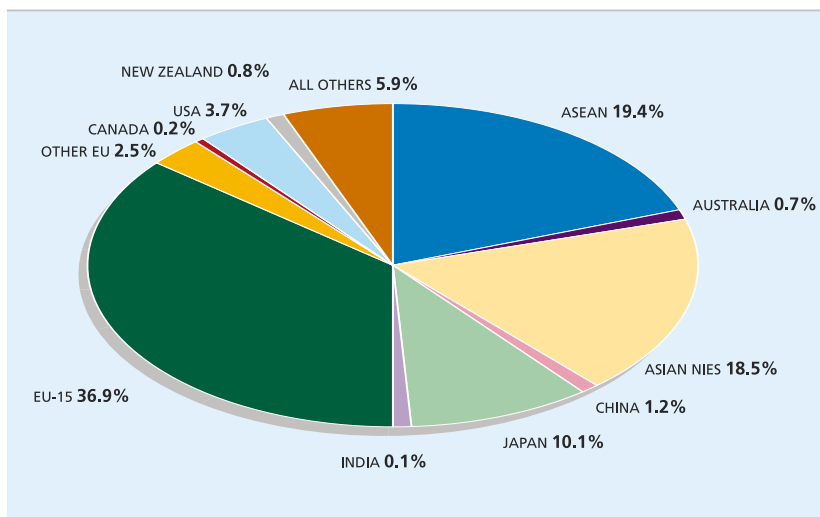

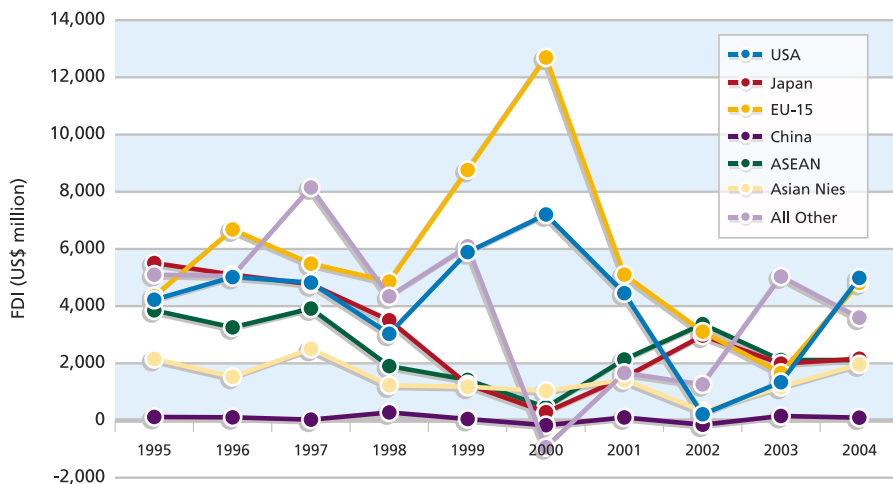

Trend of Foreign Direct Investments in BCLMV by Source Country, 1995-2004

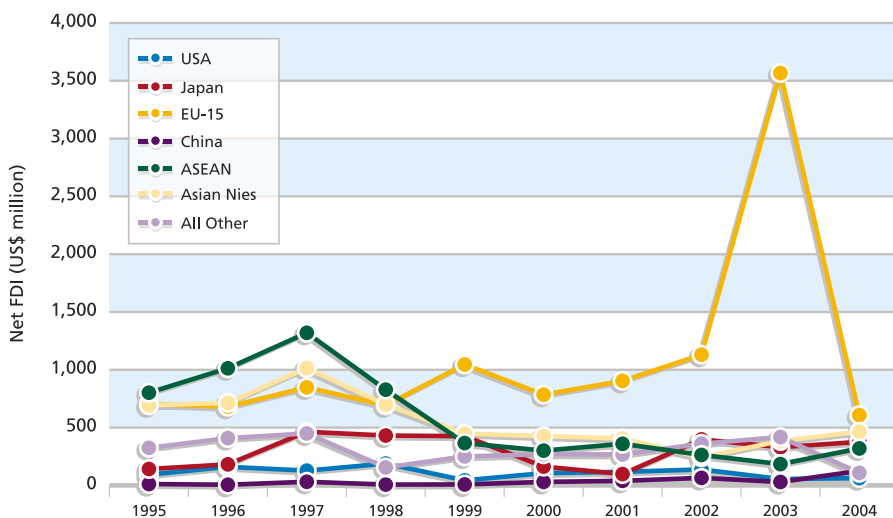

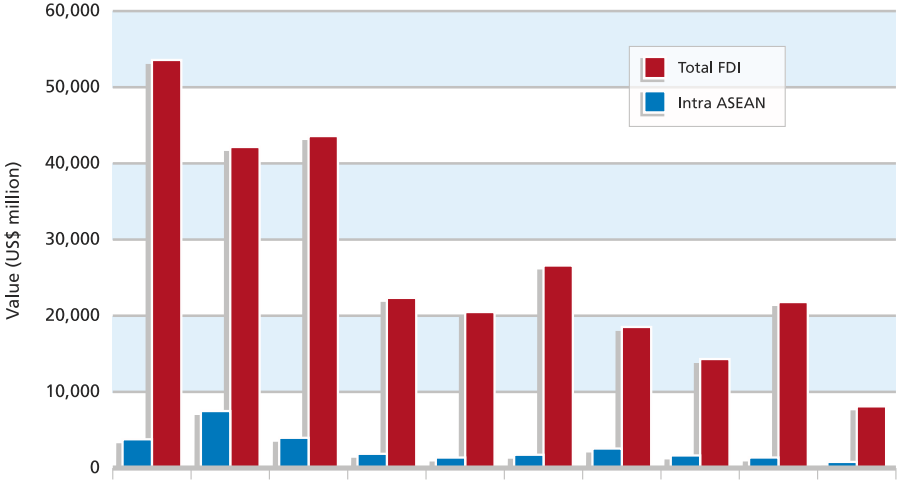

by ISIC Code 1999-2004

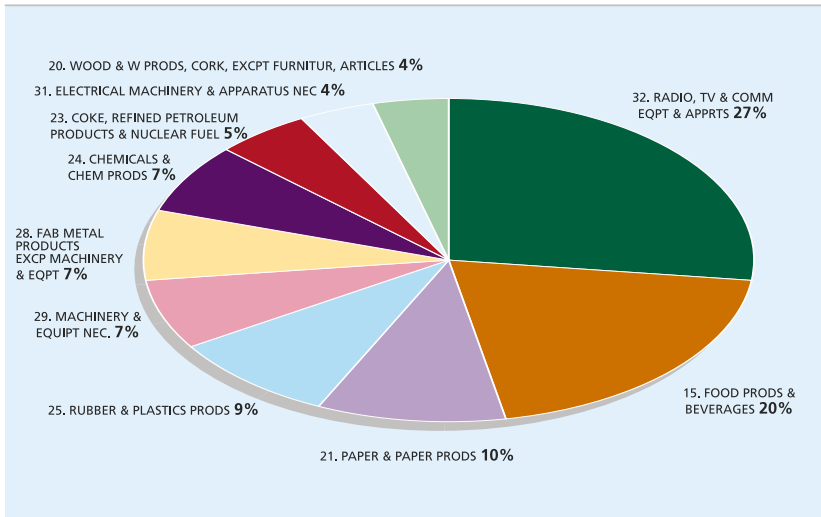
